Seniors' Future Plans, Spring 2012, Methodology & Results

Seniors at The University of North Carolina, Pembroke who were eligible for graduation in the Spring of 2012 were invited to take an online survey during the month of April. The survey is one designed for use by every school within The University of North Carolina system. It contains around 85 questions and asks about student satisfaction with, and experiences at, UNCP. An invitation to participate in the survey was sent to 520 students. The response rate was 24.23% (120 students).
