Appendix A

Student Health Services Standard Operating Procedure Medical Emergency

UNCP Student Health Services (SHS) is devoted in maintaining the health and safety of its students, employees and campus guests. In order to provide the best and safest response to a medical emergency, the following guidelines have been established:

Medical Emergencies

- 1. In the event of a sudden, unexplained or possibly life threatening medical situation or a severe illness or injury, dial 911. State the nature of your emergency and your location. Subjects suffering injuries or illness will not be transported to medical facilities in Campus Police patrol vehicles. If a subject requires transportation to a medical facility, campus safety will contact Emergency Medical Services (EMS). Under no circumstances may an employee of the university transport an injured or ill student or visitor to or from the campus.
 - *Please note: examples of medical emergencies include, but are not limited to: choking, severe chest pain and/shortness of breath, loss of consciousness, uncontrolled bleeding, debilitating injuries, violent behavior, intoxication, etc.
- 2. Please notify the Police & Public Safety department at ext. 6235 if incident has not yet been reported.
- 3. Someone should stay with the patient(s) until help arrives.
- 4. Discharge instructions are the responsibility of the subject.
- 5. Employees, please refer to Human Resources policy for workers compensation protocol in the event of injury/illness occurring on campus.
