- $78.8 \%$ UNCP students using semester of survey (compared to $59.4 \%$ in 2010)
- Over $50 \%$ describe their experiences with a CMS as positive or very positive
- $52.9 \%$ had at least one entirely online course semester of survey (compared with $29.5 \%$ in 2010)
- $14.3 \%$ had all online courses ( $8.6 \%$ in 2010)
