#### **Tutoring Program**

#### Face-to-Face Tutoring

Currently, 27 peer tutors and 2 professional tutors have been hired. A total of 77 students requested tutoring from 8/15/18 to 8/31/18 totaling 117 requests. A total of 107 appointments occurred with 75 students totaling 106. Biology (18 students), Exercise & Sport Science (11 students), Pre-Nursing (36 students) Information Technology (7 students) and Undecided (7 students) are the top majors participating in face-to-face tutoring.


