<b>Language Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Language proficiency certificate for Spanish → minimum B2 level.</li> <li>• All students <b>must apply a free Spanish test at their arrival to the university and must take a free Spanish course during their semester according to the test results. The course gives 6 credits with 45 hours of class per semester.</b></li> </ul>
