Advising

• Advising continues with a heavy focus on students that are not registered. We are also currently advising Readmits, Transfers and New Freshmen for Sp. 2021

H.A.W.K. Alerts

We currently have ~1823 referrals compared to ~2004 referrals this time last year. An additional specialist has been contacted (partial assistance) to assist with our referrals as we currently only have 2 HA specs

Probation

- Workshops were changed to online and students were emailed the remaining workshops with a link at the end of the presentation to complete quiz
- Students who were mandated to complete 30 hours of study hall are now required to complete 9 modules pertaining to financial literacy

Appeals

- Appeals process is open for Spring 2020 and deadlines are December 18th
 - We have met with 560 students to complete their Academic and Financial Aid suspension appeals for fall 2020 and summer 2020 semester
 - There have been a total of 17 appeals submitted and reviewed in the month of October 2020 for Spring 2021

Tutoring/Supplemental Instruction

- CSS tutoring is face-to-face and WEB-EX
- Our new Tutoring Coordinator Whitney Jackson has been hired and is on site
- We have hosted 444 appointments for 537 Attendees (for a max of 3 students/face-to-face appointment and 10 for WebEx) for 510 hours of tutoring
- Tutoring will be offered for students during Winter Session (Fall 3)

Students Obtaining Academic Resilience (SOAR)

- SOAR is promoting a new academic recovery model and are meeting with probation students bi-monthly
- SOAR has established collaborative partnerships with Greek Life by meeting weekly with at risk students in Greek life organizations.

Academic Success Workshops

• ASW's will run from Aug 31 – Nov 24 and all 16 will be online

Study Hall

- Study Hall is currently providing 24 hours weekly monitored study hall time and is open to all students
- Aug 24 Nov 12 will be face-to-face/social distancing and hosted in two locations with DFL as a backup
