









New Freshmen Enrollment







New Freshmen: Admission Scores


GPA: 1st YR at UNCP: **Transferred vs. Non-Transferred as Junior**







Graduate Students: Where are they from?








IPEDS Peer Comparisons FTFT Freshmen Retention Rates Cohort Fall 2017


Peer 1st-to-2nd-Year Retention Rate Comparison (Fall 2017 Cohort)


Peer 6-Year Graduation Rate Comparison (Fall 2013 Cohort)




Figure 1: Conceptual Framework of Retention and Graduation.
