



## Tenure Track Position in Accounting

The University of North Carolina at Pembroke invites applications for a full-time tenure-track faculty position in accounting at the assistant or associate levels. The position will be available in Fall 2012. Salary is competitive and commensurate with experience and qualifications.

An **earned** Ph.D. or DBA in Accounting, preferably from an AACSB accredited program, is required prior to the commencement of employment. ABD candidates may be considered if evidence of completion of their degree program prior to commencement of employment is presented.

Responsibilities include: teach undergraduate and graduate courses in accounting/auditing; engage in appropriate research and publication to maintain academic qualifications; provide academic advising; contribute to curriculum development; serve on various committees, and assume other instructional and service-related duties as assigned. Teaching responsibilities typically will span at least two accounting and auditing sub-disciplines. Course assignments may be during the day, evening and/or weekends and may include off-campus locations and online education.

Teaching load is 4 classes per semester, though an annual one-course release is granted to faculty who teach graduate classes. The University's Tenure and promotion policies and regulations are available in Section 7 of the UNCP Faculty Handbook (<http://www.uncp.edu/aa/handbook/11-12/11-12.pdf>), subject to maintaining the School's AACSB Academic Qualification standards.

Proven and documented success in undergraduate teaching and at the MBA level is highly desirable. Senior candidates must demonstrate a strong record of scholarly activities as documented by recently published articles in peer reviewed academic journals; ABD candidates must show the potential for such scholarly research;
