



Assistant Professor in Nursing

The University of North Carolina at Pembroke invites qualified applicants to apply for a fulltime faculty position in psychiatric/mental health nursing. An individual in this position will teach in both pre-licensure BSN and RN-BSN programs, during the academic year and summer session, consistent with the job description.
