



Assistant Professor in Social Work

The Social Work Department at the University of North Carolina at Pembroke invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position at the rank of Assistant, beginning August 2012. A Master of Social Work degree from a CSWE accredited program and a doctorate in Social Work is preferred. Candidates who are ABD will be considered. Two years of post social work education experience is required.

The Social Work Department includes a Bachelor and a new Master of Social Work degree. The position includes one or more areas of the BSW and MSW social work curricula, field practicum, student advisement, and curriculum development and may include on-line instruction and/or instruction at off-campus sites. In addition to instructional duties, faculty members are expected to maintain an active program of scholarship, participate in service activities, and be willing to seek and participate in extramural funding.
