Men's Cross Country The #7 men's team recorded a 2nd Place Team finish at the Peach Belt Conference Championships on October 22. The team recorded a 5th Place Team finish in the NCAA D-II Southeast Region Championship in Charlotte, NC on Saturday, November 5th. Wrestling The Braves wrestling squad will be led by 1st year Head Coach O.T. Johnson. Coach Johnson inherits a program coming off one of its best seasons to date. 
