

CURRICULUM CHECK SHEET - M.A.: Art Education 2010-2011

I am revising the M.A. curriculum and some courses may be eliminated and replaced with electives. The new curriculum will be in place the fall of 2011.

A. Education Core Courses (Required)..... 3 semester hours

- 2. EDN 5500 - Applied Educational Psychology 3 hrs (may be eliminated)
- 3. EDN 5650 - Applied Philosophy of Education, 3 hr (may be eliminated)

B. Guided Course Work Emphasizing Art Education18 semester hours

- 1. ART 5020 - Curricula in Art Education (3 hrs)
- 2. ART 5030 - Review of Research in Art Education (3 hrs)
- 3. ART 5040 - History and Philosophy of Art Education (3 hrs)
- 4. ART 5080 - Art in the Elementary and Secondary Schools (3 hrs)
- 5. ART 5090 - Leadership and Survey of Art Education (3 hrs)
- 6. ART 5110 - Art History Methods and Content (3 hrs)

Art 5080, 5090, 5110 will replace Art 5000, 5010, 5050

C. Guided Courses for Studio Area or Research Thesis6-9 semester hours

Thesis Options: (6 -9 semester hours - 3 hrs per semester)

Options I: The student may elect to produce a thesis dealing with a significant problem or inquiry in the field of art education (ART 6000-3 hrs per semester, 6 hrs required) 6 hours

Option II. Students may elect an art studio concentration that requires a Graduate Exhibit, studio thesis, and artist statement. Approval for this option is by portfolio review to indicate competence in a selected studio area (ceramics, drawing, digital arts, painting, printmaking and sculpture). Required: ARTS5xxx Special Topics, 3 hrs, Repeatable.9 hrs required 9 hours

D. Guided Electives: 6-9 hours

- EDN 5470 Advanced Classroom Management 3 hrs
- EDN 5480 Advanced Foundations of American Education 3 hrs
- EDN 5490 Effective Educational Leadership 3 hrs
- ARTS 5xxx Special Topics (Studio course name here) 3 hrs
- ART 5060 Applied Art Education Pedagogy, and Production 3 hrs

Total Hours (Minimum) 36 hours

With approval of the Program Director, candidates may enroll in graduate courses in another program at UNCP (assuming they meet its prerequisites).

A comprehensive exam is required before completion of the program. You take your comprehensive exam the last semester of your program or the semester before you graduate.

Evidence to meet the NC teaching standards will need to be dropped on Taskstream each semester when you finish the item(s). There is a fee of \$25 per semester for Taskstream or \$40 for the year. Your "Comprehensive Portfolio," including reflections for all courses, is due the last semester of your program.
