What is the priority deadline for the FAFSA?

- March 15

What recourse do I have if the FAFSA does not reflect my current financial situation?

- If you or your family has unusual circumstances not shown on the FAFSA (such as loss of employment) that might affect your need for student financial aid, submit the FAFSA and then complete a Professional Judgment Request form with the UNC Pembroke Financial Aid Office.

What documents are needed to complete the FAFSA?

- The student and parent(s) federal tax returns - 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, Telefile

What is the school code for UNC Pembroke?

- 002954

What is the scholarship application deadline?

- February 15

Why do I need to complete a FAFSA for a Stafford loan?

- The student must complete a FAFSA and admissions application for UNC Pembroke in order to be processed for any type of financial aid.

What is the difference between Subsidize and Unsubsidized loan?

- The federal government will withhold the interest on subsidized loans whereas the unsubsidized loan the interest accumulates once the loan is disbursed

What is the Federal Work-Study Program?

- ❑ The Federal Work-Study Program provides part-time jobs for undergraduate students with financial need, allowing them to earn money to help pay educational expenses.

How do I know if I am eligible for Work-Study?

- ❑ A student may qualify for work-study if they have remaining unmet need and if funds are available.
