

Survey Results For the UNC Pembroke Baccalaureate Class of 2006

Number Surveyed: 622*

Number of Responses: 207

Overall Response Rate: 33%

*Of the 604 possible respondents 531 were considered to be reachable. Response rate among reachable respondents was 39%.

Summary of Results:

For the purposes of this survey, the class of 2006 is defined as graduates from August 2005, December 2005, and May 2006. These data reveal that, as of the summer and fall of 2007, 93% of the baccalaureate graduates in the class of 2006 who responded to the survey were employed, while 29% were unemployed and seeking employment. In addition, 22% were enrolled in graduate school either part-time or full-time. 39% of respondents described their current employer as Education, while 16% indicated that they are employed in Medical fields, and 15% indicated that they are employed in Business/Industry. The majority of respondents specified a current salary of greater than \$35,000 (34%).
