

All Greek Council Executive Board

The following is a list of the positions for the proposed All Greek Council Executive Board. All members of the Executive Board must be full time students of UNC-Pembroke and active members of their undergraduate chapters. Executive Board members must maintain at cumulative and semester GPA of at least a 2.5.

President

The President of the Executive Board will serve as the official Greek Life spokesperson for UNCP's All Greek Council. The President will also be responsible for overseeing and presiding over each All Greek Council meeting. The President works in conjunction with the Greek Life Office to organize and facilitate Greek Assessment Awards every year.

The President is a de facto member of each standing committee and serves as Chair of any special task forces or committees. The President is also responsible for appointing members of the Greek community to University committees.

Vice President of Educational Programming

The Vice President of Educational Programming schedules and promotes all educational programs, including weekly programming for All Greek Council meetings as well as any additional educational programs. The VP of Educational Programming serves as Chair of the Greek Week Steering Committee. The VP of Educational Programming will also work with New Member Educators/Intake Coordinators from each fraternity and sorority to coordinate New Member Education Programming.

Vice President of Communication

The Vice President of Communication is responsible for taking minutes at each meeting, presenting them at the next meeting, and e-mailing the minutes to the AGC listserv. The VP of Communication maintains the AGC website through Club Manager and ICS and keeping the calendar current.

The VP of Communication is also responsible for ensuring that there is Greek representation at all University Open Houses, Admissions Fairs, Freshmen Orientation, Parents Weekend, and other such functions.

Vice President of Service and Philanthropy

The Vice President of Service and Philanthropy will develop a working relationship with Center for Leadership and Service in order to facilitate cooperation and joint projects. The VP of Service and Philanthropy is responsible for organizing and executing monthly service projects and soliciting participation from all fraternities and sororities. The VP of Service and Philanthropy is also responsible for coordinating special philanthropic events, i.e Relay for Life.
