



Study Abroad Scholarship Instructions

Study Abroad Scholarships awarded by the Center for International Programs are based on program, location, and need. Generally, scholarships range from \$500 (Maymester/short-term) to \$1,000 (semester), but award amounts depend on the number of applicants and amount of scholarship funding available by the Center for International Programs for that year.

DEADLINES

The scholarship application deadline is the same date as the study abroad application deadline. See the Study Abroad website at www.uncp.edu/ip/abroad/ for specific dates.

All study abroad application materials must be submitted by the deadline in order to be eligible for scholarships. All materials must be returned to:

ESSAY (Required)

Attach a one-page essay (double-spaced, 12 point font), keeping one of the following guidelines in mind:

- How have you prepared for study abroad and how will you benefit from this experience?
- What goals do you want to accomplish during your study abroad?
- The scholarship requires you to share your experience with others (see scholarship requirements below). If you have an idea about sharing your study abroad experience, what would it be?
- Describe your motivations and reasons for choosing to apply for this particular study abroad program and Location.
- If you were to start writing a book about your study abroad experience before it began, what would the title be and why?

SCHOARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Given the nature of the scholarship, recipients are expected to share their experiences with U.S. students, faculty, staff and members of the community in activities that are both academically and culturally beneficial. This will enable people to increase their knowledge of the cultures and countries and gain a better sense of the global society. If needed, the International Programs Office will assist students in finding a venue to share their experience.

TRANSCRIPT

The Center for International Programs will review your transcript from your study abroad program application. A minimum overall GPA of 2.50 is required for scholarship consideration. Some scholarships may have a higher GPA for consideration.
