Incoming Freshman Technology Scholarship

I. Information About the Scholarship

The Friends of the Library of UNC Pembroke Incoming Freshman Technology Scholarship (IFTC) is a scholarship established to assist one graduating senior from each of the seven public high schools in Robeson County who will attend UNCP, depending on fund availability. The funds to purchase the computers are paid out of the Friends' General Fund.

Candidates for consideration of the award shall be incoming freshmen who are graduates of any public high school in Robeson County and who will be full time students at UNCP. One applicant will be selected from each high school. Candidates must have a 3.0 GPA from high school. This award is not renewable.

When awarded, the scholarship will provide funding for a new laptop or tablet computer that will meet the basic UNCP computer requirements. Scholarship winners will receive the new laptop or tablet computer at the start of the fall semester of their freshman year.

II. Application Procedures

- a. An application form, two short essays, a letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, a copy of a letter of admission to UNC Pembroke, and a copy of a high school transcript must be submitted with the application.
- b. Application materials should be placed in a sealed envelope and mailed to the Library or dropped off at the Circulation Desk of the Mary Livermore Library. (P.O. Box 1510, Pembroke NC, 28372)
- c. The application deadline for the Incoming Freshman Technology Scholarship is May 1, 2012.

III. Statement of Administration

The scholarship will be awarded as funds are available. Award selection, based on the above-stated criteria, shall be made by the Board of Directors of the Friends of the Library of The University of North Carolina at Pembroke, whose decisions shall be final.
