Gale Literature Resource Center contains the electronic version of the *Dictionary of Literary Biography*, *Contemporary Authors*, *Twayne's Author Series*, and selected content from *Contemporary Literary Criticism* that covers at least 800 well-known authors. Other literary resources from Gale are also included in the *Literature Resource Center*. All items are available full text.

Gale Literature Resource Center offers a Basic and an Advanced Search. The Advanced Search is recommended as it allows a more focused search. Click the **Advanced Search** button when Gale Literature Resource Center opens.

The Advanced Search allows for searching for person (by or about), name of work, keyword and other descriptors. The Advanced Search can limit a search to a particular language, document type, intended audience and publication date. Results can be limited by content also.

Articles may be e-mailed or downloaded when the article opens by using the links in a **Tools** box. To print, use the **Print Preview** link in the **Tools** box and then the browser's print command. The article citation in MLA format appears at the end of the article.

To modify or revise a search, click **Previous Searches** at the top of the screen and then click **Revise**. Using the **Back** button of the browser will take you back to the search screen but will erase your search terms.
