Using *JSTOR*

JSTOR is an electronic archive for back issues of scholarly journals in a wide variety of disciplines. The archive of full text material in the *JSTOR* collection begins with the first issues of a journal and coverage of that journal runs until the most current 3 –5 years. Material that is in that 3-5 year frame not found in *JSTOR* may be found either in Library's print journals, other electronic databases, or maybe requested via Interlibrary Loan.

Accessing *JSTOR*

Access *JSTOR* by clicking on **Electronic Resources** on the Mary Livermore Library's home page (<http://www.uncp.edu/library/>). Click **Database Title** and then click **J** in the alphabetic list. You will see a link for *JSTOR*.

You will need to have an active library account to access *JSTOR*. Contact the Reference Desk (910-521-6656) or Circulation Desk (910-521-6516) if you have questions concerning your library account.

Searching *JSTOR*

JSTOR opens to an Advanced Search. The Advanced Search offers two search boxes with the option to add additional search boxes (**Add a Field**), and the ability to search for the terms in selected areas of the citation (**full text, author, article title, caption, and abstract**). You can also select a Boolean operator to be used (**And, Or, Not**) or a proximity operator (**Near 5, Near 10, Near 25**). The proximity operators will look for one term near the other term.

When searching you can limit your results to specific type of work (article, review, pamphlet), date range, language or specific journal title. If you are looking for only articles, click the article box.

The search can also be limited to return results only within a certain discipline(s). Multiple disciplines can be selected. Check the box next to the discipline to limit your search to that discipline. You may to select multiple disciplines depending on your search. If you were looking for information about Zora Neale Hurston, you would want to search the disciplines of African American Studies, Folklore, and Language and Literature. **JSTOR** also offers the option to limit your search to specific journals within the discipline. Click the **+** to see a list of journals with the subject.

Listed above is a typical *JSTOR* search results. If your search returns too many results, click **Modify Search** and add more search terms or click the **search within these results** and insert a search term in the box.

To view an article click the article title. The article will appear on your screen one page at a time. Click the arrows to move to the next or previous page. You can view the next and previous item in the journal by clicking on the appropriate link. *JSTOR* has links to allow you to look at the references for the article and other articles by the same author. *JSTOR* also has links to *Google Scholar* to look up for related authors and articles that cite the article. You can also click **PDF** to view the entire article. You will need to agree to *JSTOR*'s terms and conditions before the PDF appears.


Printing and Downloading

When an article opens the article information and a link to the PDF version of the article will appear above the article.

E-mailing Articles

As mentioned earlier there is not an e-mail function in *JSTOR*. However, you can download article(s) to the computer and e-mail the file(s) as attachments. It is recommended that you use your UNCP assigned e-mail account to send and receive *JSTOR* articles because the PDF files can be quite large. UNCP e-mail accounts can handle large attachments easier than most commercial e-mail accounts.

Exporting Citations

JSTOR citations can be exported to *EndNote*, *ProCite*, *Reference Manager*, *BibTex*, and *RefWorks*. To export citations selections the citations to be exported and click **Export Citation**. Select the bibliographic software to be used. Log in to the bibliographic software. UNCP has a subscription to *RefWorks*. See the *Using RefWorks* handout for instructions on establishing a *RefWorks* account.
