### ACADEMIC AND SOCIAL BENEFITS

Students who participate in the DNL<sup>3</sup>C will benefit in many ways. Examples of these benefits include, but are not limited to:

- Living and learning with other nursing majors
- Taking selected critical pre-nursing prerequisite courses together
- Completing a Nursing Freshman Seminar course that is tailored to pre-nursing majors
- Meeting Department of Nursing faculty prior to enrolling in the BSN program
- Getting to know upperclassmen who have been successfully admitted into the pre-licensure BSN program at UNCP
- Participating in special events and activities designed to introduce students to the nursing profession
- Guaranteed admission to the pre-licensure BSN program pending completion of all admission and DNL<sup>3</sup>C requirements

### GUARANTEED ADMISSION

Participants will be guaranteed admission to the nursing program their junior year as long as they:

- Successfully complete a Nursing Freshman Seminar course designed specifically for pre-nursing majors
- Complete all required pre-nursing courses with a grade of “C” or better with course repetition of no more than one due to failure
- Have both a cumulative GPA and a science GPA of at least 3.5 at time of being considered for admission and maintained throughout completion of remaining coursework
- Are an active member of the DNL<sup>3</sup>C by participating in activities as scheduled (must earn a minimum of 85/100 points annually prior to admission to the BSN program)
