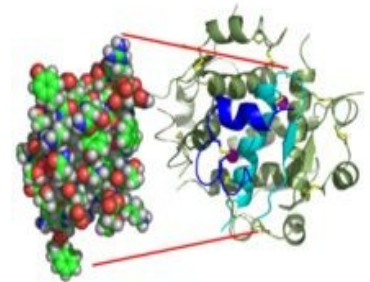


Advance Science Scholars (S4)

UNC Pembroke's Regional Center is offering a year-round Advance Science Scholars Program (S4) for **45 middle school students (7th and 8th grade)** interested in careers in the field of science. This program is sponsored through a grant from the Burroughs Wellcome Fund and provides weekly (5:00 pm-6:30 pm), tutoring sessions to help broaden the understanding of science and its content.

Scholarship Includes:

Eligibility Criteria:

- ◆ Middle School students for 2011/2012 school year
- ◆ Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5
- ◆ Interest in the science field as a possible career option
- ◆ Written Letter of recommendation from school teacher or guidance counselor
- ◆ Written essay explaining your interest in Science Field emphasizing career goals, particularly related to science
- ◆ Completed application package with official transcript

Activities: Sessions will reflect topics specific to students current science studies.
