1. The meeting was called to order by Dr. Diane Jones at 3:30 pm. The agenda and the minutes of the first two meetings ( Sept 30, 2002 and Oct 30, 2002 ) were approved.
2. Report from Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs, Dr. Diane Jones:
  - a. The Student Affairs Office is preparing for hearing requests on tuition fee increase. The Hearing Committee composed of 3 resident students, 1 commuting student, 1 faculty member and the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs will convene on Monday Nov 25 to make recommendations to the Chancellor.
  - b. Phase 2 of the University Courtyard will not materialize.
  - c. A new Counselor will be installed by January 1, 2003. Other alternatives to ease the housing problem include: local hotel and apartment facilities and campus trailers.
  - d. The Minority Affairs Officer position will be advertised soon.
  - e. Telephones have been installed in three buildings.
  - f. Preparations are underway for the Miss UNCP Pageant and the Homecoming in February.
  - g. The plans for the University Annex and Residence Hall have been approved.
  - h. Safety measures at the University Courtyard were discussed including meetings with the facility manager, the Athletics Department and student groups and the possibility of establishing a mediation program.

4. Old Business:
  - a. Discussion of the Student Grievance Policy was postponed for next meeting.
  - b. Cell Phone Policy can be found at page 53 of Student Handbook under Code of Conduct.
5. New Business:
  - a. There were 61 Who's Who applications reviewed.
  - b. The letter questioning the Miss UNCP as a beauty pageant will be discussed next meeting.
