

Recycling Program

Mission Statement

The Recycling Program at the University of North Carolina at Pembroke advocates reducing waste on campus, promoting recycling, and maintaining, and promoting a clean and environmentally conscious campus.

The program works with other chartered clubs and organizations on campus, to advocate recycling awareness. Recycling works to reduce waste and to keep our campus environmentally aware. The program strives to make University of North Carolina at Pembroke a model of an environmentally responsible institution. It is the goal of the program to keep students, faculty and staff aware of their daily impacts on the earth and to give them the tools to take positive actions to protect and sustain our living world.

All students, faculty and staff can participate in the recycling program, by utilizing the recycling bins seen around campus. The participation of each individual at UNCP ensures the success of our recycling program.

Policies

1. To retain a bin, chartered clubs and organization must attend 2 Inter-Club meetings. Previous clubs and organizations who have participated in the Recycling Program can retain the bins at the beginning of the academic year.
2. Each organization will receive one bin upon request. Each club and organization will then label the bin with the organizations name and what type of recycling the bin is for.

3. The organization is responsible for keeping the bin in good condition.
 - a. Good condition: Emptying the bin on a weekly basis and keeping the contents from overflowing. Keeping the area in and around clean at all times.
4. Inter-Club will check twice a month on each bin. When and if the condition of the bin is in unfavorable or unsightly condition, Inter-Club will notify the organization. When and if Inter-Club contacts the organization more than three times, the organization will be ban from the recycling program for the academic year.
5. All recycling bins should be on campus at all times. Clubs and Organizations are responsible of informing Inter-Club of the location of the bins.
6. ALL organizations will be responsible for taking their recycling contents to:
