- A. Opening Ceremony- The meeting came to Order at 6:00 pm.

- C. Approval of the Agenda- Senator Peoples moved to approve the agenda. Senator Whitehurst seconded the motion, and the agenda was approved.

- I. New Business-
1. Senator Rogers moved to cancel the Senate meeting for next Wednesday. the Motion was seconded by Senator Nguyen. Senator Rogers called the motion to question, and it was passed unanimously. The meeting for Wednesday, October 13th is cancelled.
 2. Senator Lee moved to reschedule Wednesday's meeting for Tuesday. There was no second, and the motion failed.
 3. Senator Rogers moved to have a table in the UC for members of the student body to enter in their name and Bravemail information into a raffle where they could win one of the free Pringle Concert tickets from the SGA. Senator Willis Reddick seconded the motion. Discussion ensued over the motion. Senator Nunnery amended the motion to include the stipulation of an Orgsync account. There was discussion on this amendment. Senator Kevin McLean amended the amendment to the main motion. This amendment stated that we should split the tickets. Ten would go to students who have Orgsync accounts and ten would go to students who "like" SGA on Facebook. Senator Rogers removed his main motion from the Table.
 4. Senator Nunnery moved to place a table in the UC where students can make an Orgsync. After creating an Orgsync students could then place their names in raffle for ten of the SGA's free tickets. A second raffle for the remaining then tickets could be held for Facebook fans. Senator Rogers amended the motion to hold one raffle, which would include all students. If a student is both a fan on Facebook and a member of our Orgsync page they double their chances at winning a ticket. The amendment to the main motion passed unanimously. After further discussion the motion passed with all "aye" votes, with the exception of Senator Nguyen and Senator Sherwood who abstained. It was decided that SGA would hold a raffle for the 20 free Pringles Extreme Concert tickets. This raffle would be for students who are either "like" the SGA Facebook page, or who are members of Orgsync. If a student is involved with both websites then they may enter their names into the raffle twice.
