### **1. Chair**

- a. Peter has forwarded to faculty governance a question about adding a new representative from the Office of Global Engagement to SACL. Someone in the executive committee of faculty senate mentioned that there may be an issue with the balance of ex-officio and faculty members stated in our bylaws.
- b. Peter has reached out to Crystal Walline, chair of the special committee on student evaluation of instruction, about how our committee can help their efforts (particularly in understanding students' perspectives on SEIs) but hasn't heard back or been able to find a time to meet with her and discuss. He hopes she will attend our final meeting of the semester.

### **3. Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs (Kyle Smith for Jeff Howard)**

- a. Filled several new positions (details in addendum)
  - Faculty Resource Fair- drop in and visit with SA- April 25, 11am
  - Dr. Hurst- new Director of Student Housing and Residence Life
    - Village Apts- former student residents will be able to reclaim space
    - Housing prices increased slightly, and will increase 5% in a few apartments, and some costs were reduced in other halls; UNCP is still lower than other UNC-system schools of a similar size.
      - Costs will help with paint, new mattresses, etc.
    - North Hall computer lab- working on computer labs there for international student requests; sent forms to submit to use other halls, but no one submitted forms- will grant access to other halls if anyone needs it.

- SGA is holding elections, transitions beginning soon
- MH Awareness Week in April with MH First Aid training
- International students concerned about dining options during Spring Break, as only one dining hall was open during that break (11am-3pm)
