Easement Mapping Based on current understanding, various family members own the residences, so obtaining the required easements to run the water line should not be difficult. However, the work needed to prepare the easement map will dictate surveying so that accurate easement maps and legal descriptions can be obtained. Agencies Having Jurisdiction. NCDOT

to approve encroachments, and State Water approvals. Based on the actual size of the project, a submittal to NCDEQ for a Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control Permit needs confirmation. At this time do not not anticipate since the construction area should be less than one acre in size. Erosion control measures will however be incorporated into the design to ensure compliance with applicable regulations.

Develop and obtain Legal Descriptions,

which can be submitted to the applicable UNCP legal counsel for review and any necessary changes addressed. Once the maps and legal descriptions are finalized, they will be provided to UNCP for execution and recording. The easements must be obtained before the contract is awarded to perform the construction work on the project.





The development of north campus is planned for the next 20 to 50 years.
