Return to Title IV (R2T4) Policy for Institutional Aid

Overview

This policy outlines the procedures for the return of Institutional Aid when a student withdraws from the University of North Carolina at Pembroke.

Policy Details

1. Withdrawal Prior to Disbursement Date

- If a student withdraws before the FA disbursement date, all Institutional Aid for that term will be removed.

- The withdrawal date is considered the last date of class attendance as documented by academic records.

- The student will be responsible for any balance owed to the institution due to the removal of aid.

2. Withdrawal After Disbursement Date

- If a student withdraws after the disbursement date, they are deemed to have earned 100% of the Institutional Aid for that term.

Implementation

The Financial Aid Office will monitor withdrawals and ensure the timely and accurate adjustment of Institutional Aid according to this policy. Students are encouraged to understand the impact of withdrawal on their financial aid and speak with a financial aid counselor before making the decision to withdraw.

Student Responsibility

Students are responsible for any outstanding balances on their accounts after the adjustment of aid due to withdrawal. Failure to settle these balances may affect future registration and other institutional services.

This policy ensures transparency and fairness in the administration of Institutional Aid, aligning institutional practices with student needs and regulatory requirements.
